<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Sharing follow-up actions since the last meeting:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- use of data to inform action planning- identification of underachieving pupil groups- analysis of attainment by 'term of birth'- making visions a reality- rigour of time tables teaching and assessment, including division facts▪ Ofsted – the new framework: Implementation<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Sharing ways in which we make time for revisiting content and dealing with gaps in knowledge and skills.
Items for novice subject leaders:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Ofsted: <i>“Leaders identify areas for improvement and take effective action to tackle these, including through professional learning that ensures teachers develop the expertise needed to deliver the curriculum effectively.”</i><ul style="list-style-type: none">- Sharing ways to support teaching staff in improving mathematics teaching, .e.g. models of support, INSET delivered and the follow-up to ensure impact
Items for experienced subject leaders:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ofsted: <i>“Leaders deploy staff effectively so that all pupils have access to high-quality teaching.”</i><ul style="list-style-type: none">- Interventions – looking at curriculum content for targeted pupils- Discussing how support staff, such as teachers, HLTAs, LSAs, are appropriately trained to teach relevant content- Relating this to practice in the classroom where additional support is unavailable
