<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Sharing follow-up actions since the last meeting:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Opportunities for LSA training</li><li>- Looking at interventions and TAs' approaches when supporting pupils</li><li>- Inclusive practice – what interventions are happening and their impact</li><li>- Adaptive teaching</li><li>- The Scaffolding Framework</li><li>- Supporting children towards independence</li></ul></li><li>▪ Ofsted – the new framework: Assessment</li><li>▪ Also, sharing ways in which schools will be celebrating NSPCC National Number Day on 6<sup>th</sup> Feb. to engage and motivate learning in maths</li></ul>
Items for novice subject leaders:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Book look and focus on assessments to establish standards</li><li>▪ Comparing evidence across schools at the same standard</li><li>▪ What does WT/EXS/GD look like?</li></ul>
Items for experienced subject leaders:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ What is the school's approach to assessment of mathematics?</li><li>▪ Focus on assessment against National Curriculum objectives not coverage</li><li>▪ How can we ensure this is consistently effective to move learning forward?</li><li>▪ What support is/could be provided?</li></ul>
Maths Leaders will need to bring:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ A selection of maths books from across the school</li><li>▪ A selection of assessments (e.g. tests taken) for the same children</li><li>▪ Outcomes for these children, e.g. standards at which they've been assessed</li><li>▪ More detail will be sent to Maths Leaders the week before the meeting</li></ul>
