Items for all:
▪ Sharing follow-up actions since the last meeting: - Question whether to join SLT in book looks - Use of the National Curriculum for assessment – in INSET - Gaps analysis and feeding this into planning - Find out what teachers are doing as a result of the quizzes/assessments/gaps analysis - Use fewer pictorial representations in pre/post assessment quizzes - Consider if pictorial representations are needed throughout a unit and in quizzes/assessments - Look at assessment – consider White Rose assessment use - Think about when assessment will be completed ▪ Sharing strengths and areas for development with each other to benefit from others' actions and outcomes – sharing good practice.
Items for novice subject leaders:
▪ To reflect on the current status of mathematics in your schools. ▪ To discuss what 'works' in mathematics and what needs changing or developing ▪ To evaluate this year's actions
Items for experienced subject leaders:
▪ To share recommendations of low floor, high ceiling tasks to provide access for all learners and how these can be adapted through effective questioning, additional scaffolding and challenge.
Maths Leaders will need to bring:
▪ Maths Action Plan 2025 – 2026 and the knowledge of the evidence to support achievements this year and what may need further development ▪ An example of a low floor, high ceiling task that has been used successfully in school and the questioning or adaptations made. .
